The author agrees to the publication of the above article (both in the printed and electronic version) and the additional information like the academic pedigree, his work address and email as written in the agreement mentioned in §2.

The author, without any financial remuneration, agrees to give UKSW all copy rights for the above publication mentioned in §1 not limited by time or options, especially for the following use:

1. Publishing and distributing of the article in printed and electronic version
2. Coping and saving on the external drives
3. Entering into the computer memory
4. Entering into the on-line libraries
5. Entering into the marketing
6. Entering into the internet data base of magazines

UKSW commits itself to send the author one copy of the periodical „Canon Law” in which the article written by the author has been published.

Any disputes that could arise from the signing of this agreement will be dealt with amicably and in case they can't be resolved in that manner, the internal UKSW judicial system could table the matter.
